### PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

This programme is at NQF Level 9 and it has been designed for participants who want to develop their Construction Project Management knowledge and skills at postgraduate level without leaving their employment. This two-year part-time programme incorporates 'blended learning', where technology and traditional modes of delivery are effectively merged.

- hold an approved qualification together with a minimum of three years appropriate industrial experience.
